1. Mayor Hank Warden called the July 17, 2020 Special Vote Canvass Meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

2. Discuss and consider Resolution 2020-11-17 on vote canvass and declaration of the results of the General Election held on Nov, 3, 2020 for the purpose of electing three City Council Members for two-year terms. Due to the postponement of the regular May 2020 election per Texas Governor Abbott, the terms of office will be from November 17, 2020 to May 17, 2022.

The resolution states Rogers, Parker and Novak are duly elected Post Oak Bend City Council members for a Governor Abbott/COVID-19 special term adjustment ending in May 2022. It also certifies the November 3, 2020 City Election.
